What are Hepatitis B (Hep B)
and Hepatitis C (Hep C)?

Hep B and **Hep C** are viral infections that can lead to liver disease and cancer.



Hep B spreads through semen, vaginal fluids, and blood.



Hep C spreads through blood.

Protect Yourself

1. Get the **Hep B vaccine**.
2. Get tested for **Hep B** and **Hep C**.
3. Use condoms.
4. Avoid sharing any **injection equipment or solutions** if you inject drugs, hormones, steroids, or silicone.
