Total Viral Hepatitis Initiative FY2018 funding level: **\$1,456,158** increased to **\$2,275,229** through a state match

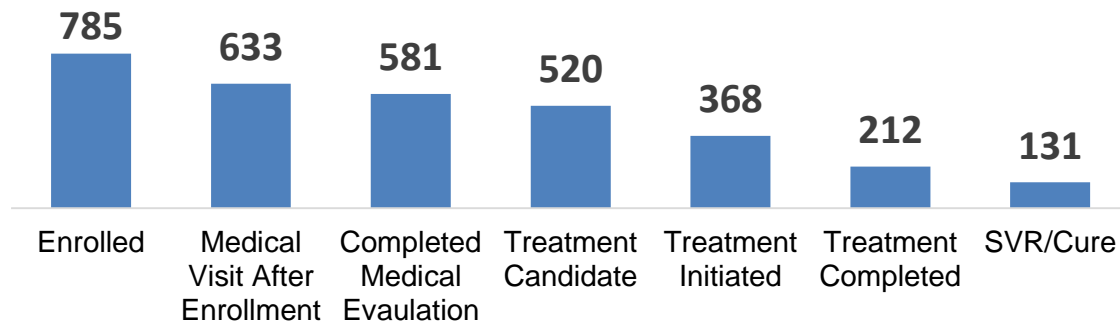
Check Hep C Patient Navigation Program

FY2017 (July 1, 2016 – May 31, 2017)

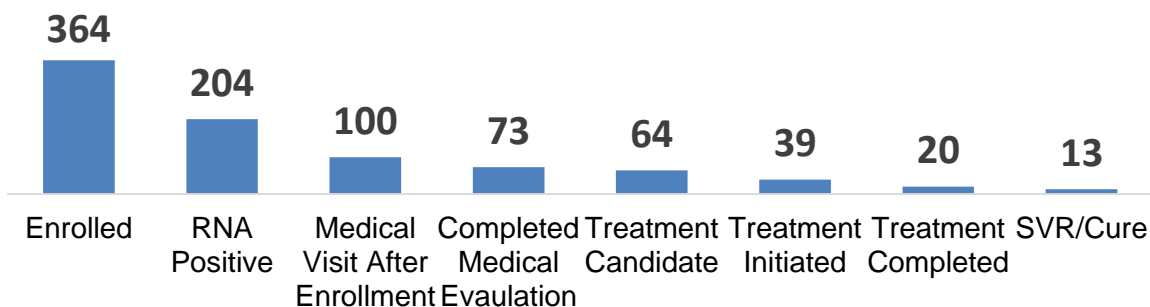


More than **1800 Hep C Patients** enrolled since January 2015.

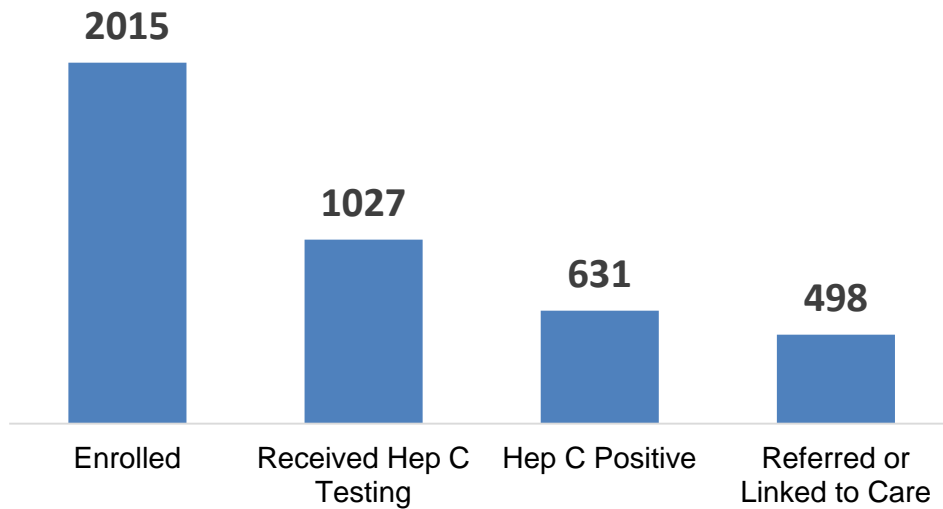
NYC Hep C Peer Navigation Program
