2016 Hospital Survey

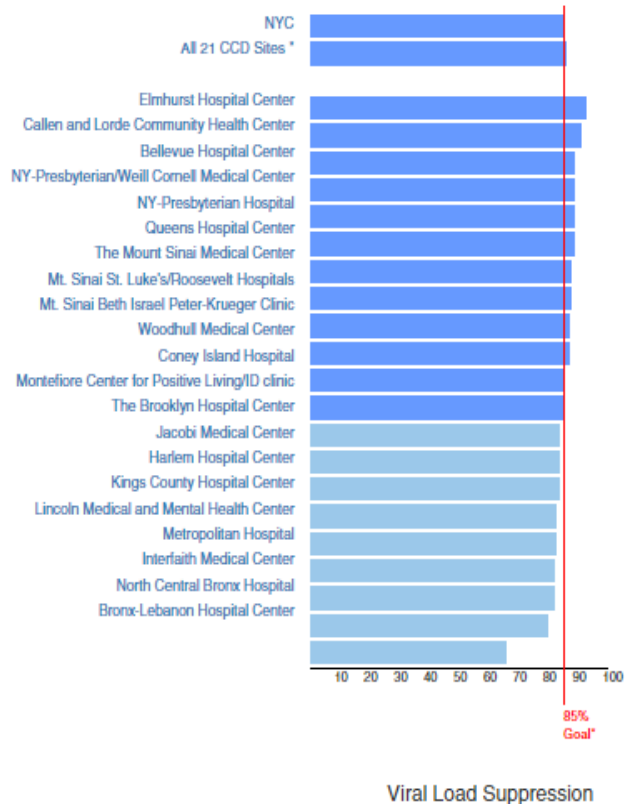
- Screening & Linkage to Care

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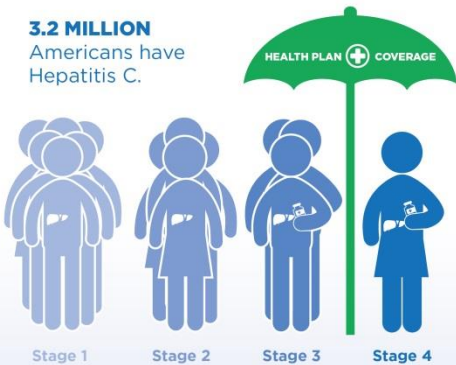
