During the school year, UAU provides substance use prevention services at 17 different afterschool sites across Staten Island:

- Five elementary school COMPASS sites (PS 20, PS 44, PS 45, PS 55, and PS 56).
- Five intermediate school SONYC sites (IS 7, IS 24, IS 34, IS 72, and IS 75).
- Two Beacon Centers (PS 18, IS 2).
- One high school (Port Richmond)
- Four NYCHA Cornerstone Community Centers (West Brighton, Mariner's Harbor, South Beach, and Berry Houses).

During the summer, prevention services are provided at all of the sites listed above with the addition of PS 53, St. John Lutheran, and Staten Island Tech.

UAU substance use prevention services include:

- Evidence based curriculum
- Individual assessment and counseling services
- Parenting skill building services
- Referral to specialized services as needed

Over the course of the year, UAU provides evidence-based curriculum and counseling services to over 3,500 youth ages 5-24.

UAU also provides ACS preventative services from our beacon center for family services located in PS 18. ACS preventative services include:

- Case management (tracking safety of youth, assistance with linkage to community resources/supports, financial assistance, legal assistance, employment assistance, medical coverage, etc.)
- Counseling (domestic violence, academic supports, stress management, parenting skill building, etc.)
- Referral to specialized services as needed

UAU ACS preventative services are available to all of Staten Island.
