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NYC COUNCIL EDUCATIONAL BRIEFING ON VIRAL HEPATITIS IN NYC

- The NYC Council Educational Briefing on Viral Hepatitis in NYC was held on February 26, 2026, at 250 Broadway in Manhattan.
- The briefing was organized by the Hep Free NYC Advocacy Leadership Committee and sponsored by NYC Council Member and Health Committee Chair Lynn Schulman.
- The NYC Health Department presented preliminary hepatitis B and C surveillance data from 2024, and community partners provided an overview of the NYC Council's Viral Hepatitis Prevention Initiative (VHI) programs and the community budget request.



 - Build a relationship with NYC Council Members and staff




UPCOMING NYC COUNCIL HEALTH COMMITTEE HEARING
