The purpose of the Harm Reduction Peer Academy is to educate people who can deliver interventions with the goal to reduce the harm caused by prohibition, substance use, and high-risk behaviors. Graduates are eligible to apply for stipend positions at Housing Works.

We believe that, often, the best Harm Reductionists are those who use Harm Reduction services or have needed them in the past. Harm reduction is generally tailored to engage and address unsafe practices within marginalized populations, but harm reduction can be found anywhere.
