VIRAL HEPATITIS PREVENTION INITIATIVE (VHI)

- Since 2014, the Viral Hepatitis Prevention Initiative has been funded by the NYC Council to promote hepatitis B and C screening, treatment, and prevention.
- On June 30, 2025, the NYC Council published the <u>FY2026</u> <u>Adopted Expense Budget.</u>
- The NYC Council designated \$2,247,454 to the Viral Hepatitis Prevention Initiative.
